Growing

Our Grüner Veltliner was planted at the Mound Vineyard in 2013 and the first vintage was harvested in 2016. Paying homage to its spiritual home of Austria, we are watching it quietly flourish here.

Winemaking

The grapes were hand harvested and pressed to stainless steel and seasoned oak barrels to harness the varietal character and impart texture and complexity.
